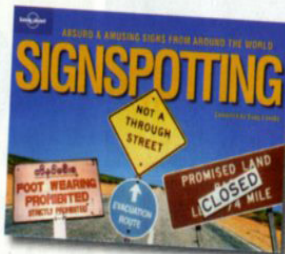

## Tuscan artists' homes

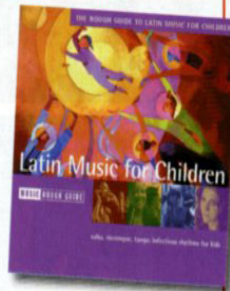
