The material is produced in several sizes, making it suitable for wearing as either a bandana, a sarong or even a protective blanket that can be laid on a sun-lounger or recliner.

The repellent is activated by rubbing or continual movement and is effective after several machine washes. The bandana size costs £7.99 and the largest, single sheet size costs £19.99.
